# VS Code Quick Facts



- First Release in 2015 by Microsoft
- Based on the Electron framework
- **Partly** Open Source under the MIT License and available on GitHub
- Available for Windows, Linux and macOS
- Visual Studio Code  $\neq$  Visual Studio



# VSCodium



- Open-Source alternative to VS Code
- Licensed under the MIT License
- Telemetry is disabled

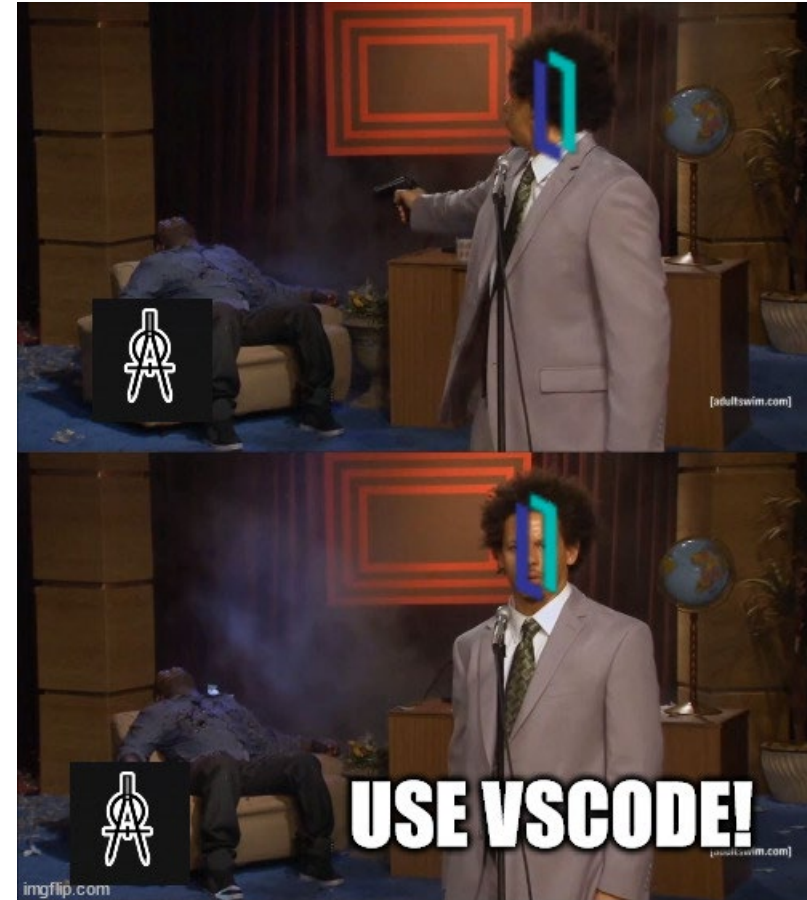

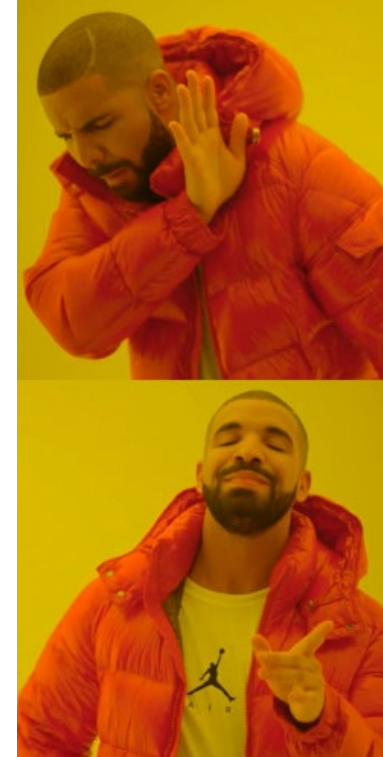

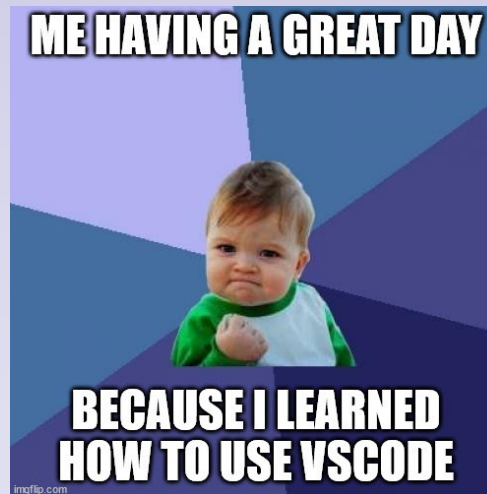
